


The following depicts a juror checking the web to see if he is required to report for service the following day. The juror enters his badge number and is told to report for jury service at a certain time at a specific court location.







This same juror checks back the next morning after failing to appear for service and gets the following message.




This is another common scenario for reporting instructions. The juror isn't need in the morning of her service day, but is told to check back after 11:00 a.m. for possible service in the afternoon.




When the juror checks back after 11:00, she finds that she doesn't have to report for service in the afternoon, but is told to check back after 4:00 pm. to see if she is needed the following day.




The following screens show a juror postponing her service to a future date.




The first available service date from her currently scheduled March, 6th appearance is April 10th.



She selects May 15th for her new appearance date.



She selects financial hardship as the reason for the postponement of service.



She now can complete the postponement and verify her new service date by clicking the yellow command button.
